Back into the swing of things

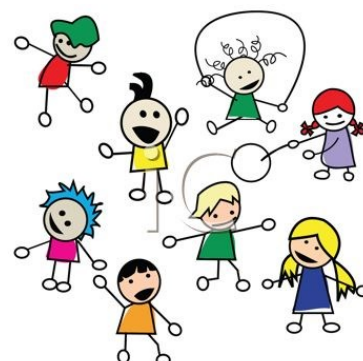

Please help the office—school dinner administration

The office has to every week chase parents who have a debt on their school dinner account. This takes a great deal of time. We appreciate it may be hard to remember how much you have in your child's account, but you do have the facility to set up an automatic Top up alert yourself as below. This alert can only be setup by parents themselves.

- 1) Log in to your account,
- 2) Click "VIEW/EDIT PROFILE" from the left hand menu,
- 3) Then select "ALERT SETTINGS" from the left menu,
- 4) On the page you will see a section marked "Balance Alerts" with a box marked "Threshold". Please Type in the amount you want to be alerted at, i.e. £2.50
- 5) Tick the text alert box and email alert box if required.
- 6) Scroll down to the bottom and click "SAVE"
