Dear Applicant,

Thank you for requesting an application pack for the position of class teacher at Kemble Primary School. I really hope that you like our school enough to apply for the post.

We are a popular, small school, with 4 classes situated in the village of Kemble, near Cirencester. Kemble has a station with a mainline service to London. We are a friendly, caring school and are proud of our strong links with the local community and the church. Since September 2012 we have been in a formal partnership with Siddington CE Primary School and work very closely together. The successful candidate may be given opportunities to work across the two schools. As a federation we are also now looking at joining a Multi Academy Trust with other local schools.

The position on offer is for a job share, in the afternoons, for our Year 3 / 4 class. Mrs Rogers teaches English and maths each morning, so the afternoons will be teaching all the other subjects! The class is delightful. The children are well behaved and the classroom enjoys super views!

Our school details are as follows:

Reception Class (Oak) - 14 pupils - teacher Mrs Newton who is also the deputy

Year 1 / 2 Class (Beech) - 31 pupils - teacher to be Miss Hancox who was the afternoon Year 3 / 4 teacher

Year 3 / 4 Class (Horse Chestnut) - 29 pupils - teacher Mrs Rogers in the mornings, afternoon position to be filled

Year 5 / 6 Class (Chestnut) - 21 pupils - teacher Mrs Parmiter

All classes have TA support in the mornings, and some afternoon support if needed. There is a village playgroup on site, and the school runs a breakfast club from 7:30am to 8:30am and an after school club from 3:00pm until 5:45pm. The school also offers a good range of after school club activities run by teachers, parents and local sports groups or interested parties.

We have quite low EAL, SEN & Pupil Premium numbers in the school. Our last Ofsted was graded as Good and we are currently awaiting an inspection.

We have a strong, committed team who work together extremely well and we are looking to appoint a dynamic, highly effective and inspirational teacher to join us. We are looking for someone who understands the pressures of working in a small school and can excel in the classroom. We believe in helping teachers to develop their career by giving the support and the opportunity to undertake CPD and positions of responsibility.





The children are happy, interested and very keen to learn. They participate enthusiastically in both academic and extra-curricular activities, behave well and enjoy coming to school. The parents and governors are very supportive of the school and work well with the staff. We have a committed team of teaching assistants who support children and teachers in the classroom and by taking small groups.

Visits to the school are encouraged. Interested candidates should contact the school office to arrange a convenient time.

Applications should be sent to the school by 12 noon on Thursday 12th May. We aim to inform shortlisted candidates and seek references on Friday 13th May and hold the interviews on Thursday 26th May.
